IRI: Filer School District's elementary staff made great attempts this past year to improve literacy in grades K-3. Interventions were more intentional. In January, it was evident that progress toward goals had become stagnant. Changes were made and another level of progress was made. However, even with these efforts, we fell short of our goals in every grade level. Most all staff received additional training this summer. Changes for this school year include: additional training in interventions, schedule changes, and personnel changes. Team meetings will focus on literacy progess.

ISAT: Filer School District had some areas of great success on the ISAT (6th - 8th grade) and areas of concern. Each school building has started the process of doing a deep dive into their data to help determine areas of weakness and how to improve. Goals will be revisited on a montly basis and adjustments will be made as needed.

College and Career Advising: Filer High School set a new goal last year to ensure every graduating senior had a plan upon graduation. We had a 97% completion rate on these plans. Of the three students who did not submit a plan, one of them is currently attending boot camp and the other two were incapable of completing plans. The district will continue with this same goal for the upcoming year.
